Guidelines for Ring Finders

- 1) All lost item requests, whether it be from theringfinders.com, Facebook, or the club website, will be handled as club functions and all proceeds will be deposited into the club treasury.
- 2) All referrals to the club shall be forwarded to the list of volunteers.
- 3) A time and location will be determined by the organizing member.
- 4) The hunt will start once all members who have responded have arrived at the designated time and location. Hunting the designated area prior to the designated time is prohibited and will subject the individual to removal from the Ring Finders group.
- 5) Any moneys donated will be turned over to the club regardless who receives it.
- 6) Never refuse a donation on a club function. Gratefully take it and turn it in to the Treasurer.
- 7) Hunters will be only paid SRARC members who are registered on the volunteer list. Callouts are made by email so each volunteer must have an email address registered with the club.
- 8) To be counted as a hunter, you must be actively operating a metal detector on the hunt. Teams working together with a single detector will be counted as only one hunter.
- 9) Club members are free to create websites or social media sites to advertise their own private recovery services. To prevent any conflict of interest problems the member will be removed from the SRARC Ring Finders callout list for as long as those sites exist.
- 10) You must be active in at least 10% of the total hunts per year to be included in any Ring Finders appreciation event.
- 11) Volunteers will be required to sign up each year so the list of volunteer contacts can be kept current.

Note: If you recover an item that is not associated with an organized Ring Finders event, any reward offered is yours to do with as you see fit.
