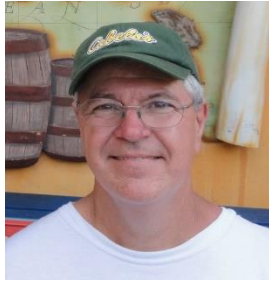

**Our May Meeting will be on May 21<sup>st</sup> due to Bill Jackson's being closed on Memorial Day**

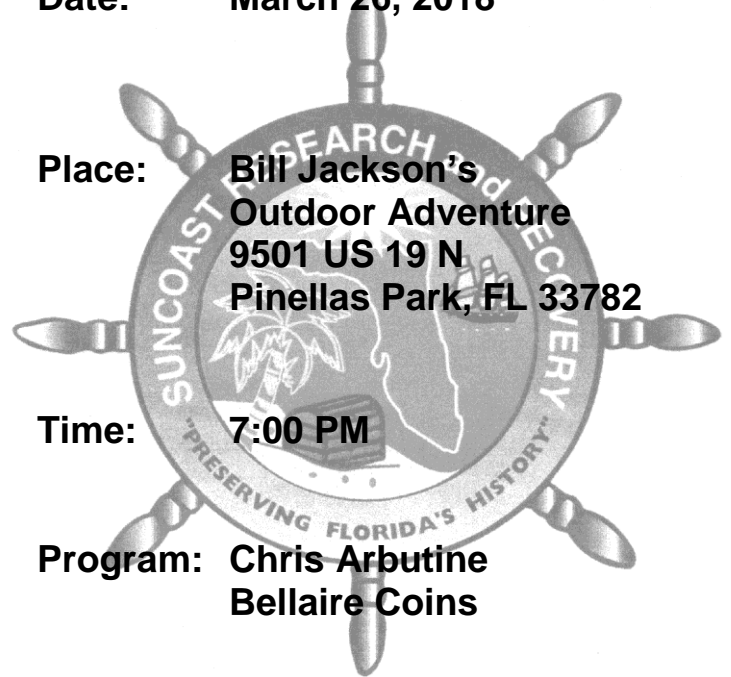

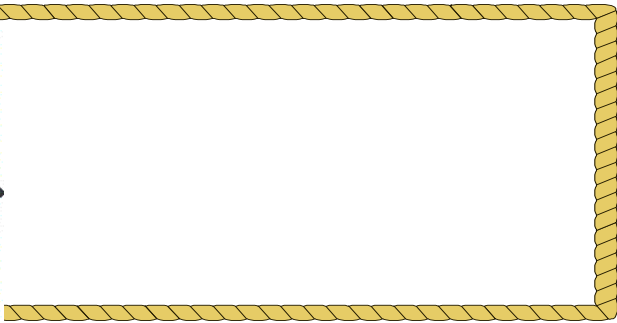
